2. What is something from the message that stood out to you, was new to you or challenged you?
3. When was a time you felt you weren't good enough to do something? What did you do?
4. Respond to the statement "My availability to God is more important than my capability." Is this true? Why or why not?
5. Read Exodus 3:12. What from your past makes it difficult for you to do the things God is calling you to do? What do you think God thinks about your past in comparison to the future that He is wanting to take you to?
6. What weaknesses are keeping you from following God's call? What excuse can you give that makes you incapable of doing what God has asked of you?
7. Which of God's responses to Moses in Exodus 3 & 4 speak to you? Why?
8. What step is the Holy Spirit inviting you to take in response to this?
