1 Kings 19:19 - 21

GOING DEEPER QUESTIONS:

1. What does a typical, ordinary day look like for you? Do you feel or believe that your day has the potential of being more than ordinary, that it could change the world? Why or why not?
2. What is something from the message that stood out to you, was new to you or challenged you?
3. Respond to the statement "God calls ordinary people to be part of what His ridiculous plan to do big things." Is this true? Why or why not?
4. What are some examples of ridiculous commitment to God that you have seen?
5. Describe a time God invited you to be part of something even though you didn't have all the details? What was the result of your obedience?
6. Elisha killed the oxen & burned the plough as a sign of not going back, of trusting that God was leading him to something. What security do you need to step away from that will help you move toward God's call?
7. How would you describe your level of trust in God? What might be keeping you from fully trusting in Him?
8. How is the the Holy Spirit inviting you to respond? What step(s) of obedience can you start taking today?
