



## GOING DEEPER AT HOME

### OCTOBER 24: DOING THE DISHES

When the meal is done, how quick are you to offer to do the dishes? Some of us might willingly volunteer to wash the dishes while others of us would rather move to the living room and visit with our guests. Washing dishes may not be something some of us want to do, it removes us from the action, from being with people. Someone else can do that for us. In the final part of our series we hear Jesus call us to a radical way of living, that in a world fight for power and position our response is humility.

#### SCRIPTURE:

John 13:1 - 17

#### GOING DEEPER QUESTIONS:

1. Do you like washing the dishes after a big meal while everyone else is visiting in the living room? Why or why not?
2. What is something from the message that stood out to you, was new to you or challenged you?
3. Respond to the statement "In a world fighting for power and position our response is humility." Is this true? Why or why not?
4. Do you identify more with Judas who fought for power or the other disciples who fought for position? Why is that?
5. When is a time that you found yourself fighting for power or position? Why did you fight for it and did you get it? How did it make you feel?
6. Read verse 3. Why is it important that Jesus knew His role and was confident in His identity? How does this influence or impact us in our choices to fight for power & position?
7. By disrobing, putting on a towel and washing the disciples' feet Jesus was doing the unthinkable, He was doing something He wasn't supposed to. When is a time that you did something similar & what was the outcome of it?
8. What is something you can start doing so that you pay attention to the needs of other people and respond in humility?
9. How is the the Holy Spirit inviting you to respond? What step(s) of obedience can you start taking today?
