SCRIPTURE:

2 Kings 6:1 - 7

GOING DEEPER QUESTIONS:

1. What is a time you failed? How did that experience impact you?
2. What is something from the message that stood out to you, was new to you or challenged you?
3. Respond to the statement "God is all about ridiculous recoveries." Is this true? Why or why not?
4. Share a time when God helped you find something you didn't mean to lose. What did you learn from your experience?
5. What things in your life most often cause you to lose your spiritual edge & why? (Failure, discouragement, other people, etc)
6. If you feel like you've lost your spiritual edge, where do you think you might have lost it?
7. Recovering a lost axe head may not seem like a big deal to some of us, but it points to how God cares about the small details in your life. How does this truth impact you & your relationship with God?
8. How is the the Holy Spirit inviting you to respond? What step(s) of obedience can you start taking today to get your spiritual edge back?
