GOING DEEPER QUESTIONS:

3. Respond to the statement "Hurry is the enemy of life." Is this true? Why or why not?
4. What is something in your life that you do that is necessary and good but at times distracts you from being with Jesus?
5. Jesus longs to enter into the daily activities of our life, the same activities that we think make life busy. Where in your life has Jesus been trying to enter that you perhaps have been missing what He is trying to do? What could Jesus be trying to tell you?
6. How easily are you distracted, whether by things you think you need to do or by unnecessary things, like technology? What could Jesus be trying to tell you?
7. How good are you at setting aside your need to do be doing something and just be with Jesus? What would sitting with Jesus look like for you at this season of your life?
8. What step is the Holy Spirit inviting you to take in response to this?
