4. The Jewish understanding of neighbour went beyond the person living next to you to include everyone your life touched. Why is this an important distinction?
5. Read Luke 10:29. Why does the expert in Jewish law ask this question? Who in your life would you like to get a pass on loving? Why?
6. How willing are you to pay the price to love someone who from every perspective does not deserve to be loved?
7. Where is the the Holy Spirit inviting you to pay the price to love? What can you do to see that take place?
