4. Think of a time when you did not have enough and you weren't sure you'd make it. What was that experience like, how did it impact your relationship with God?
5. Read verses 3 - 5. If this was you, how open would you be to asking your neighbours for jars? Why?
6. When have you experienced God's ridiculous provision? How did this impact you?
7. Why do we allow our limited resources to be what keeps us from partnering with God in living a life of epic faith?
8. How is the the Holy Spirit inviting you to respond? What step(s) of obedience can you start taking today?
