GOING DEEPER AT HOME

OCT 2: BECOMING LIKE JESUS

In 1991 Gatorade launched an ad campaign called *Be Like Mike* featuring NBA player Michael Jordan. At the time Jordan was at the pinnacle of his basketball career and almost every kid playing the sport wanted to be like him. We often want to be like famous or prominent people. But what about Jesus, do we ever want to be like Him? The first century Jewish invitation to follow a rabbi meant you would become like your teacher. Jesus invites us to become like Him.

SCRIPTURE:

Luke 6:12 - 16 & 6:39, 40

GOING DEEPER QUESTIONS:

1. Who did you want to be like when you were a kid & why?
2. What is something from the message that stood out to you, was new or challenged you?
3. Read Luke 6:12 - 16. What do you know about the disciples Jesus chooses? What does this say about Jesus' approach to discipleship?
4. Respond to the statement "who we become is more important than who we are. Is this true or not?"
5. Do you find yourself hung up on who you currently are or look forward to who Jesus is leading you to be? Why or why not?
6. In Luke 6:39 Jesus says a blind person can't lead another person. Who is He referring to & what does this look like today?
7. In Luke 6:40 Jesus says a student will become "fully trained" and be like the teacher. What does it mean to be fully trained? How is Jesus training you?
8. Read 2 Corinthians 3:18. Ultimately this is about change, about transformation. How do you typically respond to change? What is an area in your life Jesus wants to transform?
9. As you plot out your life 10, 20, or more years into the future, who are you becoming? Do you see Jesus or more of you?
10. What step(s) is the Holy Spirit inviting you to take to be become like Jesus?
