### GOING DEEPER QUESTIONS:

2. What is something from the message that stood out to you, was new to you or challenged you?
3. Respond to the statement "while it may not make sense to us, God is at work, don't give up hope." Is this true? Why or why not?
4. Share a time when you experienced the cycle of hope, feeling like things weren't good but could get better but it was taking a long time. How did this affect your faith in God?
5. Do you need everything God does to make sense or are you okay with it being unclear? Why is that? How would your relationship with God change if you let go of the need for clarity?
6. Read Zechariah 9:9 & Matthew 21:1 - 11. Why is it important that Matthew connects Jesus to the prophecy of Zechariah 9:9?
7. How important is it for us to know that God is still at work even though it doesn't make sense to us?
8. How is the the Holy Spirit inviting you to respond? What step(s) of obedience can you start taking today?
